Jewellery

Your child may wear a watch (not smart watch), stud earrings or sleepers to school but these must be removed for any sporting activities. For health and safety reasons, no other jewellery should be worn including no hoop or dangly earrings.

Jewellery on PE Days

For health and safety reasons, all jewellery, including stud earrings, must be removed for PE and other sporting activities, and long hair should be tied back. If your child is unable to remove their earrings by themselves, it should be arranged that they do not wear studs on their PE days. Please note that staff are not allowed to remove or look after jewellery for children. The safest place is at home.
