School Work Whilst Self-isolating

As we always aim to support your child in their education through high-quality provision, if your child is required to self-isolate for longer than 3 days, we will do the following:

Scenario	Action
A child is ill or self-isolating and not able to attend your lessons (for longer than 3 days)	Teachers will make themselves familiar with the Oak National Academy, they will email the parents weekly signposting them to the content on the Oak that most matches the content to be studied in class.
A bubble is self-isolating and therefore the children and staff are not in school.	If teacher is well then they will swap to delivering their lessons via TEAMS daily. If teacher is unwell then they should signpost to the Oak content that most fits with what they should've been doing during the lessons in class.
The school is closed due to an outbreak or local lockdown.	If teacher is well then they will swap to delivering their lessons via TEAMS daily. If teacher is unwell then they should signpost to the Oak content that most fits with what they should've been doing during the lessons in class.
Where parents do not have access to online learning.	Printed learning packs will be prepared by the class teacher and sent home for parents.

We will be trialling one hot meal a week, each meal will be individually packed.

The hot meal option will automatically be ordered for those children entitled to a free meal currently.

All meals are priced at £2.40 each and payment would need to be made by bank transfer also by Tuesday. Parents at Holbeach St Marks also have the option of paying by card, please speak to Mrs Lane.

Illness

If your child is displaying **any** of the Covid 19 symptoms you must not send them to school, the symptoms are as follows;

- High temperature
- Persistent cough
- Loss of smell or taste

A runny nose or a sore throat without a temperature are not Covid 19 symptoms.

If your child is taken ill whilst at school we will quarantine them and ask you to collect them straight away.

In both of these situations you need to do the following;

Phone 119 or use the following link <https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/coronavirus-covid-19/testing-and-tracing/get-a-test-to-check-if-you-have-coronavirus/> to book a test.

- If the result is positive your child must isolate at home for 10 days and the rest of the household must isolate for 14 days.
- If it is negative you need to send us confirmation of the test result then your child can return to school.
- If you are not willing or able to get your child tested then your child must isolate for 10 days and the rest of the household must self-isolate for 14 days.
