Church Farm - China, Australia and The Den

On Monday 28th June, China, Australia and the Den Classes will be going to Church Farm in Stow Bardolph as part of their term 6 topic. If the weather is going

to be hot, please make sure that you have put sun cream on your child and that they have a sun hat to wear. They will be leaving school at 9.30am and will return to school for approximately 3pm. The children will need to have a packed lunch with them. If your child is entitled to free school meal, a packed lunch can be provided. The actual cost of this trip, which includes admission, coach costs and insurance, is £15.50. We are subsidising the cost and will need to ask for a voluntary contribution of £10.00 towards the cost of the trip.

Rand Farm Park - Brazil, Mexico and Canada

On Tuesday 29th June, Brazil, Mexico and Canada Classes will be going to Rand Farm Park in Lincoln as part of their term 6 topic. If the weather is going to be hot, please make sure that you have put sun cream on your child and that they have a sun hat to wear. They will be leaving school at 9am and will return to school for approximately 4.30pm. The children will need to have a packed lunch with them. If your child is entitled to free school meal, a packed lunch can be provided. The actual cost of this trip, which includes admission, coach costs and insurance, is £14.60. We are subsidising the cost and will need to ask for a voluntary contribution of £10.00 towards the cost of the trip.

Go Ape - Spain and Portugal

On Tuesday 6th July, Spain and Portugal Classes will be going to Go Ape in Thetford as part of their term 6 topic and our Y6 leavers trip. If the weather is going to be hot, please make sure that you have put sun cream on your child and that they have a sun hat to wear. They will be leaving school at 9am and will return to school for approximately 3.45pm. The children will need to have a packed lunch with them. If your child is entitled to free school meal, a packed lunch can be provided. The actual cost of this trip, which includes admission, coach costs and insurance, is £31.25. We are subsidising the cost and will need to ask for a voluntary contribution of £20.00 towards the cost of the trip.
