## New Guidance from The Government on Covid 19 For Education Settings

The new guidance states that more evidence has emerged that there is a very low risk of children becoming very unwell from coronavirus (Covid 19), even for children with existing health conditions. Most children originally identified as clinically

extremely vulnerable no longer need to shield and should still attend school, unless their GP/Consultant advises against it. Children who live with someone who is clinically extremely vulnerable should also still attend school.
