Cool Milk

Milk is provided in school for the under 5-year olds and for those parents who have paid for their child to receive milk daily. If you would like your child to have milk every day, you will need to go on the Cool Milk website to order and pay for this.

Forms and letters being returned to school

All forms and letters being returned to school should be put in the post box. The box can be found outside the school's main reception. Please make sure that your child's name and class are on the envelope before posting it in the box.

Illness

If your child is displaying Covid 19 symptoms, you must not send them to school. The symptoms are as follows:

- High temperature
- Persistent cough
- Loss of smell or taste

A runny nose or a sore throat without a temperature are not Covid 19 symptoms.

If your child is taken ill whilst at school, we will quarantine them and ask you to collect them straight away. In both of these situations, you need to do the following:

- If the result is positive, your child must isolate at home for 10 days and the rest of the household must isolate for 14 days.
- If the result is negative, your child can return to school.
- If you are not willing to get a test, then the whole household must self-isolate for 14 days.

School Work Whilst Self-isolating

As we always aim to support your child (in their education through high-quality provision), if your child is required to self-isolate for longer than 3 days, we will do the following:

Scenario	Action
A child is ill or self-isolating and not able to attend your lessons (for longer than 3 days)	Teachers will make themselves familiar with the Oak National Academy. They will email the parents weekly signposting them to the content on the Oak that most matches the content to be studied in class.
A bubble is self-isolating and therefore the children and staff are not in school.	If the teacher is well, then they will swap to delivering their lessons via TEAMS daily. If the teacher is unwell, then they should signpost to the Oak content that most fits with what they should've been doing during the lessons in class.
The school is closed due to an outbreak or local lock-down.	If the teacher is well, then they will swap to delivering their lessons via TEAMS daily. If the teacher is unwell, then they should signpost to the Oak content that most fits with what they should've been doing during the lessons in class.
Where parents do not have access to online learning.	Printed learning packs will be prepared by the class teacher and sent home for parents.
