Illness

If your child is displaying Covid 19 symptoms you must not send them to school, the symptoms are as follows;

- High temperature
- Persistent cough
- Loss of smell or taste

A runny nose or a sore throat without a temperature are not Covid 19 symptoms.

If your child is taken ill whilst at school we will quarantine them and ask you to collect them straight away, in both of these situations you need to do the following;

- If the result is positive your child must isolate at home for 10 days and the rest of the household must isolate for 14 days.
- If the result is negative your child can return to school.
- If you are not willing to get a test then the whole household must self-isolate for 14 days.

Face Masks

As the Government guidelines have stated, primary school children do not need to wear masks in school. We would like all adults entering the school reception to wear a face mask.

Water Bottles

All children will need to bring their own water bottles to school. At present we are not allowed to use the water fountains.

Snacks

On Monday 7th all children need to bring a healthy snack for breacktime but from Tuesday 8th fruit will be provided for children in reception to year 2 and FSM children, we will not be providing snacks for other year groups and they should continue bringing their own. A healthy snack would be a cereal bar (not chocolate covered), a plain biscuit, a piece of fruit or dried fruit or a fruit-based snack.
